As part of the ongoing initiative to support eMERGians at this critical time, eMERG hosted a very well received webinar on COVID Facts and Myths. Presented by Dr.Sumitha Nayak, eMERG VP and a highly qualified and experienced pediatrician (MD, DNB Fellow of Indian Academy of Pediatrics, International Certificate in Vaccinology (IVI, S Korea), PGDMLS, PGDGC)


The webinar focused on COVID prevalence, early symptoms & signs, investigations required, managing at home and some common myths about COVID. Awareness of these facts was imperative during this pandemic and eMERG is happy to share these key take aways with you.

Dr. Sumitha walked us through the following:

- Typical disease onset (symptoms 2 3 days after contact),
- Challenges of limiting transmission (COVID most infectious 0.7 days BEFORE symptoms manifest),
- Early symptoms (Fever- high grade that is unremitting despite medication, Cough, Headache, Sore throat, Loss of smell and taste, Redness of eyes, Diahorea, Nausea, Tiredness, Difficulty in breathing),
- How to reliably diagnose (RTPCR test),
- Quarantine protocols (isolate in separate room with attached toilet, no contact with other senior citizens, only ONE person as caregiver throughout quarantine),
- Monitoring investigations (6 min walk, oxygen saturation, D Dimer, CT scan, CRP, IL6),



Understanding Vaccination: 28th May 2021



Second in our series of COVID related webinars "Understanding Vaccines" dealt with what is the need of the hour – vaccinations and the impact of COVID on our psyche.

Presented by Dr. Sumitha Nayak, eMERG VP and a highly qualified and experienced pediatrician, the webinar focused on the need to vaccinate, the benefits of vaccination, the different kinds of vaccines and their efficacies, COVID variants and the psycho social impacts of the COVID pandemic-facts that everyone needs to be aware of at this time.

Dr. Ramitha Pai talked about the psycho social impact of the COVID pandemic

Causes anxiety about loved ones health, fear about uncertainty on personal and professional front, anger at loss of control and changes to normal life, pressure to be vigilant at all times, curtailed social freedom especially for adolescents and children, loss of job, increased responsibilities at home

- Coronaphobia panic, obsessive behaviour, difficulty in focusing, restless, irritable, mood swings, negative feelings
- Negative outcomes domestic violence, sexual abuse, alcohol dependency, smoking, drug abuse, psychological issues in older children such as depression, moodiness, irritability
- Potential post COVID effects brain fogging, memory affected and inability to remember, lingering physical problems
- Soar past these problems by practicing self-care, having a positive outlook, working to a schedule and reconnecting with others, reinvesting emotionally in yourself and others'
